Directions:

The Arboretum is located 3.8 south of Route 66, on scenic Woody mountain road, on the west side of Flagstaff. The last half of Woody Mountain Road is not paved but suitable for all vehicles.

From Flagstaff:

On Route 66 take the last Stop light, (Woodlands Village Blvd.) continue on Route 66 to Woody Mountain Road (about 1 mile) turn left onto Woody Mountain rd. and drive 3.8 miles to the Arboretum.

From I-17/I-40:

Take Exit 191 off I-40 west. Turn right at stop sign at end of ramp. This is Route 66 East. Drive about 2 miles to Woody Mountain Road and turn right. The Arboretum is 3.8 miles down Woody Mountain Road.
